

T H E M E

Not For Us to Decide

It will be impossible to distinguish between true and false disciples. It is not for us to sort them out; God will do that at the final judgment.

Table Talk

- How does the enemy sow weeds among the wheat?
- Why do you think the enemy does this?

LIVE IT

The Parable of the Weeds is a warning that one day Jesus will separate those who truly follow him from those who don't. It's a good wake-up call for all of us to examine how we're living. The good thing is that Jesus always leaves room for repentance! We can always repent and turn to him! But we must not judge others; that's God's job. We must love everyone the same and live our lives as examples. Hopefully, if we live like Jesus, it will bring conviction to those who don't. Then we will be right there, with arms wide open, when that person comes to repentance.
