

It was the practice of Martin Luther to use the Lord's prayer to structure his daily prayers. He would recite each verse and stop after each one to pray personal prayers aligned with that petition. For example, after reciting, "Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy..." he would pause and praise God in specific ways for relationship, provision and the nature and character of God. Use Luther's model as a guide for your praying this week. Report back to the group what the experience was like next time you gather.

How does Jesus fulfill God's character as described in Exodus 34:6?

How has Jesus taught you to act like God in practical ways?

Where in your life do you sense the Holy Spirit transforming you in the image of Jesus?
