

THEME

God Is Recreating the World Through His Son

John 1:1-18 serves as a prologue to the Gospel of John. It poetically tells us how God brought new life through the incarnation of his Son, the Word made flesh. All who put their faith in him will be born again.

Why do you think most people didn't recognize Jesus for who he was?

Is it possible for us to miss Jesus working amongst us? How so?

What does it mean to be born of God?

STOP & DISCUSS

How does Jesus fulfill God's character as described in Exodus 34:6?

How has Jesus taught you to act like God in practical ways?

Where in your life do you sense the Holy Spirit transforming you in the image of Jesus?
