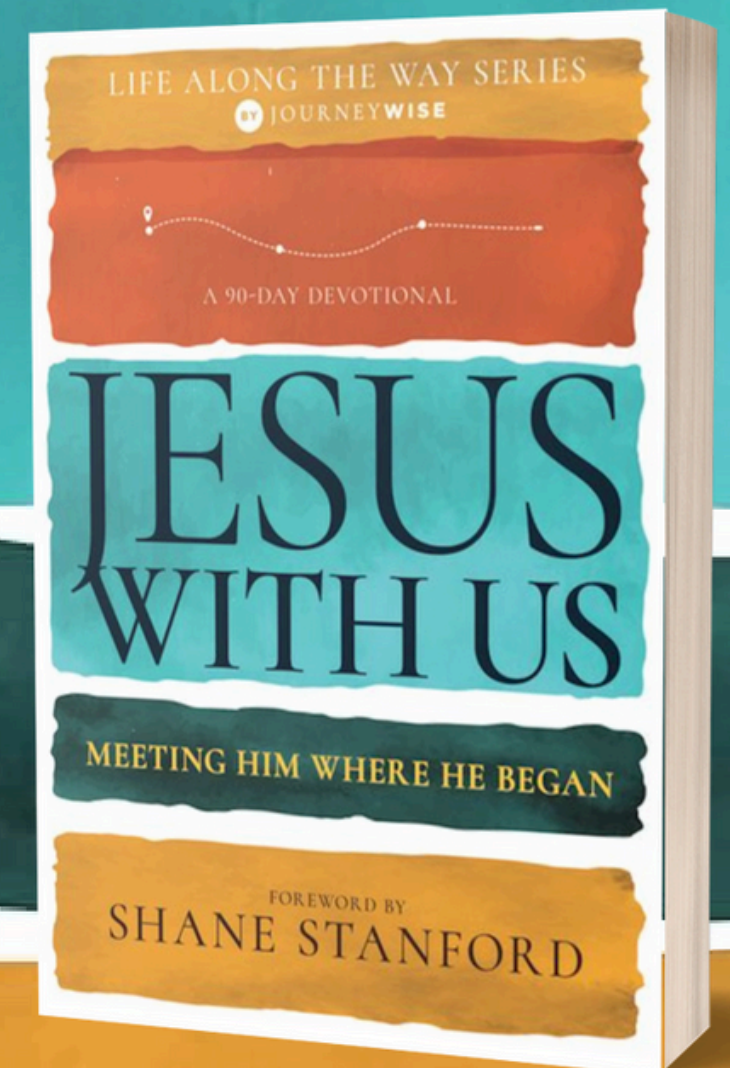

Man Healed of Leprosy

Read: *Mark 1:40-45*

In the story of the man healed of leprosy, we are provided a window into the compassion of Jesus. Jesus desires not simply to save us from hell one day, but to bring wholeness to our lives right now. It is important for us to note not simply his willingness to heal, but the means by which he does so.

STOP & DISCUSS

Lepers had to yell “Leper” or “Unclean”. What kind of mental toil would this have caused? Can you imagine if we had to yell our deepest shame repeatedly?

Have you ever been in a season where your prayers were filled with desperation? If so, when? How did God respond and meet you through those times?

STOP & DISCUSS

Had you ever considered Jesus' means of healing in this story before? What does it reveal about the heart of our Savior?

To whom is Jesus calling you to show action-oriented compassion?

From what would you ask Jesus to heal you today?

This man cannot contain the truth of what Jesus has done in his life. Relational evangelism, sharing what God is doing in our lives, is the most effective means of sharing the Gospel. This week, ask someone if you might share what God has/is doing in your life. The purpose is not to convert or convince – simply to share.
